



## WATERSENSE & WATER EFFICIENT PRODUCTS COMMITTEE

### DRAFT COMMITTEE GOALS & OBJECTIVES

*September 2008*

**Goal 1.** Foster the development of a robust and credible water-efficient product labeling program.

**Objective 1.** Encourage the completion of the WaterSense program design, including the framework for 3rd party certification, partnership agreements, and measures to build and maintain the integrity of the WaterSense brand.

**Objective 2.** Support budgetary resources needed to maintain and expand the WaterSense program.

**Objective 3.** Encourage a transparent and workable process for evaluating and selecting additional products, equipment, and services for future specification development, and for scheduling existing specifications for revision.

**Goal 2.** Provide multi-stakeholder input to the development of strong and effective specifications for water-efficient products and equipment and related professional services.

**Objective 1.** Provide a forum for discussion of stakeholder interests in the issues regarding new or revised WaterSense and Energy Star specifications.

**Objective 2.** Make timely recommendations from a multi-stakeholder perspective in support of WaterSense and Energy Star criteria that set product eligibility to maintain functionality and performance and achieve an improvement of 20% or more in water use efficiency (when compared with standard product offerings).

**Goal 3.** Provide multi-stakeholder input to the development of minimum efficiency standards for water-using products and equipment where such standards are under consideration by regulatory bodies.

**Objective 1.** Provide a forum for discussion of stakeholder interests in the issues regarding new or revised minimum water efficiency standards.

**Objective 2.** Make timely recommendations from a multi-stakeholder perspective in support of new or revised water efficiency standards that seek to maximize the water savings that are technically feasible and economically justified.
